RE: AIR QUALITY MONITORING

Thank you for your email of 27th November, I apologise for delay in responding.

We have now heard from Dorset Council, your contact there is Darren Naraine, and his email is Darren.naraine@dorsetcouncil.go.uk.

The Parish Council has two working groups currently set up, these are the GP Working Group and the Clapps Mead Working Group. There will soon be a third when we start looking at Foss Orchard.

We view Air Quality as an important issue and believe that it should sit apart from the parish council as a Community Group, run by members of the Chideock community. This does not preclude a councillor from attending the Community Group should any of them wish to do so. If a councillor does attend, then their status will be as a resident and not as a parish councillor. We have taken this stance to ensure that the parish council is not committed to any action or spend, as may happen if a parish councillor were to attend.

We understand that you have your own social media to publicise reports and other information relevant to Air Quality, our Clerk is maintaining the new parish council website, and I am sure she would be prepared to create a page for Air Quality information. You will need to speak to Tan about this. The HF website will be taken down in December 2024, I advise you to save any files and/or documents that you may need.
