RE: CARTERS LANE, CHIDEOCK

A recent accident on the A35 on Chideock Hill has once again thrown up the importance of Carters Lane to Chideock and the surrounding area.

The Chideock Parish Council is extremely concerned about the 18 month closure of the road. We were informed earlier this year that your Engineers were working on plans to resolve the situation. The Parish Council would ask to see these plans as a MATTER OF URGENCY.

There is much speculation in the village and surrounding area, and I am not exaggerating when I tell you that people are feeling very uncertain and fearful of what an 18 month closure notice may mean. We have reason to fear that nothing will be done except a further 18 month closure notice as this has happened in this area before.

I would ask you please to contact us and tell us what is proposed to allow this extremely important road link out of the village to open again.
